Application Requirements

Applicants must fulfill the following criteria:

- 1 Hold a nationality other than Japanese.
- 2 Fulfill either 1) or 2):
 - 1) Obtained 230 points or more on the Japanese of the Examination for Japanese University Admission for International Students (conducted by JASSO) (Only results of exams taken in the academic year 2023 and 2024 are accepted)
 - 2) Obtained N2 on the Japanese-Language Proficiency Test (JLPT) conducted by the Japan Foundation and Japan Educational Exchanges and Services, or equivalent language skills.
- 3 Able to renew the student visa status as stipulated in the Japan Immigration and Refugee Control Act.
- 4 Live in Japan at the time of submitting the application to Osaka Gakuin University.
- 5 Fulfill either 1) or 2):
 - 1) Have already completed 12 years of secondary education outside of Japan or will complete it before 31st March, 2025. Up to 3 years of education at a Japanese high school can be included in 12 years.
 - 2) Have been recognized to have the same academic qualification as stated in 1) above by Osaka Gakuin University.

Application Documents

Application form; transfer certificate of application fee; photograph; statement of purpose; high school diploma (proof of expectation to complete said program); academic transcript; and copies of the residence card, passport, and residence certificate.
