#### Hiragana, Katakana

#### Kanji

There will be Kanji lesson one time per week from the 4<sup>th</sup> week after you have studied Hiragana and Katakana. There will be quizzes from the following week.

#### Quiz

There will be grammar tests after each lesson. There will be vocabulary quiz and other quiz.

#### Mid-term and Final exams

There are mid-term and final exams for grammar and kanji. Grammar exams will be writing, listening, and oral.

#### **Others**

There will be conversation, writing, listening, speech, and presentation practices.

#### Poster session in April.

The Poster session will be held in April; it will be in Japanese.
