#### Kanii

#### Quiz

There will be grammar tests after each lesson. There will be vocabulary quizzes and other quizzes.

#### Mid-term and Final exams

There are mid-term and final exams for grammar and kanji. Grammar exams include writing, listening, and oral.

#### **Others**

There will be conversation, writing, listening, speech, and presentation practices.

#### Poster session in Dec.

The Poster session will be held in December; it will be in Japanese.
