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## Online Korean Language Program

### Program Description

Online Korean Language Program is for beginners of Korean language; an introduction to Korean alphabets, grammar and culture for students who have never or little learned Korean before. This program is designed to improve integrated skills of speaking, listening, reading and writing and to gain basic fluency in daily conversation. The main emphasis is the activities of role play, games and various materials. There are extra sessions of language exchange with Korean students who are learning Japanese or of support from Korean students fluent in Japanese (Zoom-pal).
